Engineering Leadership Scheme Standard Award

Engineers make a difference, conceiving and creating the things that save, enable and enhance lives. The career choices available to an engineer are vast, offering job satisfaction and prosperity.

The Engineering Leadership Scheme was created by The Royal Academy of Engineering to help undergraduate engineering students, the engineers of tomorrow, realise their potential and achieve their goals.

The Standard Award is open to all British engineering undergraduates in any year and is designed to further develop your interest in engineering as a career through a series of activities and short courses organised by the Academy.

These vary each year, but may include courses about international development work, renewable energy technology or project management. Many are held at the Royal Academy of Engineering in London.





A Standard Award entitles you to apply to take part in these courses, with the cost of the course covered by the Royal Academy of Engineering.

You are also entitled to apply to take part in outward bound-type West Country Initiative and Leadership (WILD) courses held on Dartmoor.

You may also apply for a £300 work experience grant to enable a summer work placement by assisting with travel and accommodation costs..

The main selection criteria for these awards are:

- You must be registered on an accredited university engineering degree course (BEng or MEng)
- You can be in any year of your degree course
- You must be a UK citizen unless you have taken part in a Young Engineers club or activity, a Headstart course, the Engineering Education Scheme (England), a Smallpeice Trust course or taken a gap year with The Year in Industry
- You must be expecting to pursue a career in engineering after graduating
- You must want to benefit from the courses on offer at the Royal Academy of Engineering

Are you an engineering undergraduate (BEng or MEng) in any year of your degree and interested in the Standard Award?

You need to register online for the scheme between August and October 2011.
